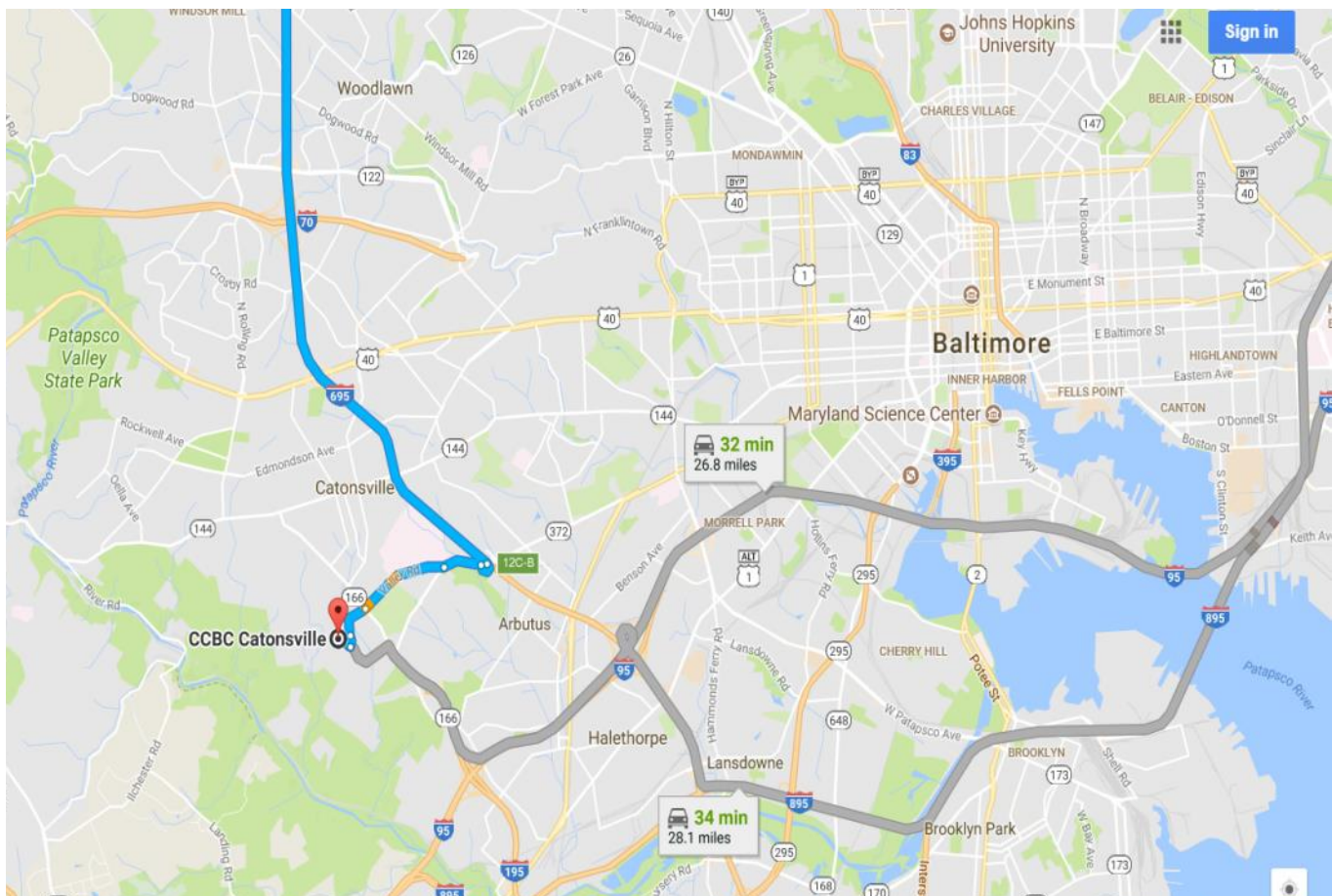

*Kirk P. Rodgers, a long-time stalwart and pillar of the Maryland forestry community, passed away last year at the age of 83. His career spanned over six decades and included positions with the U.S. Forest Service, Baltimore County, and the Organization of American States where he served as Director for Sustainable Development and Environment. Kirk also managed his family forestry holdings which consist of 8,000 acres in Maryland and Virginia. Kirk's grandfather, Fred W. Besley, was the first state forester of Maryland.

The MD/DE Division of SAF and the Maryland Sustainable Forestry Council would like to commemorate Kirk Rogers contributions to forestry in Maryland with a plaque placed on a stone base located at the entrance to the Fred W. Besley Demonstration Forest. **Donations from SAF members will go to the construction and installation of the plaque in Kirk's memory.**
